6. Belgium	Antwerp, Ostend & Kortrijk Airports; EUR 2.2 million. Direct grants and deferral concession fees to region. (TF)	29 September 2020 (until 31 December 2020)
7. Poland	All airports; EUR 32 million. Direct grants. (Compensation Damages)	29 September 2020 (15 March - 30 June 2020)
8. Cyprus	Hermes Airports; EUR 22.2 million. Loan. (Ad-hoc measure)	17 November 2020
9. Romania	Regional Airports; EUR 4.4 million. Direct grants for airports with 200.000 – 3mppa. (Compensation Damages)	23 November 2020 (16 March - 30 June 2020)

12. Slovenia	Ljubljana Airport; EUR 5 million. Direct grant. (Compensation Damages)	2 February 2021 (17 March - 30 June 2020)
13. Ireland	All airports; EUR 26 million. EUR 20 million compensation for damages State airports (Dublin, Shannon, Cork). EUR 6 million grants & compensation of unrecovered fixed costs smaller airports (Knock, Kerry, Donegal). 1. Cyprus	Cyprus; EUR 6,3 million. Incentive airlines to re-establish connectivity, grants per passenger if load factor is 41%-70%. (TF)	1 July 2020 (until 30 June 2021)
2. Romania	Oradea Airport; EUR 1 million. Airport support scheme with grants to airlines resuming/starting operations. (TF)	27 July 2020 (until 31 December 2020)
3. Slovenia	Ljubljana Airport; EUR 5 million. Grants for airlines re-establishing connectivity, based on flights (50%) and passengers (50%). (TF)	16 November 2020 (until 30 June 2021)
4. Romania	Sibiu Airport; EUR 1.7 million. Airline incentive scheme. (TF)	20 November 2020 (until 30 June 2021) 7 July 2021 Prolongation until 31 December 2021
5. Romania	Targu Airport; EUR 1.6 million. Airline incentive scheme with grants to airlines resuming/starting operations. (TF)	7 July 2021 (until 31 December 2021)

Norway	Sandjeford Airport; NOK 90 million (EUR 8.5 million). Grant as compensation for damages.	31 July 2020 (ESA) (1 March – 31 December 2020)
Iceland	Kefvlavik Airport: ISK 15 billion (EUR 100 million). Share capital increase Isavia.	18 December 2020 (ESA) (1 March – 30 June 2020)
